Johnson Professional, the position of VP, Patient Safety Strategy has been eliminated, along with over 300 other senior level positions at SC Johnson and Son. As a result, Paul will be leaving DebMed as of June 22, 2018, after 10 years of service.

Paul leaves behind a legacy of innovation, commercial achievement and new category creation.
